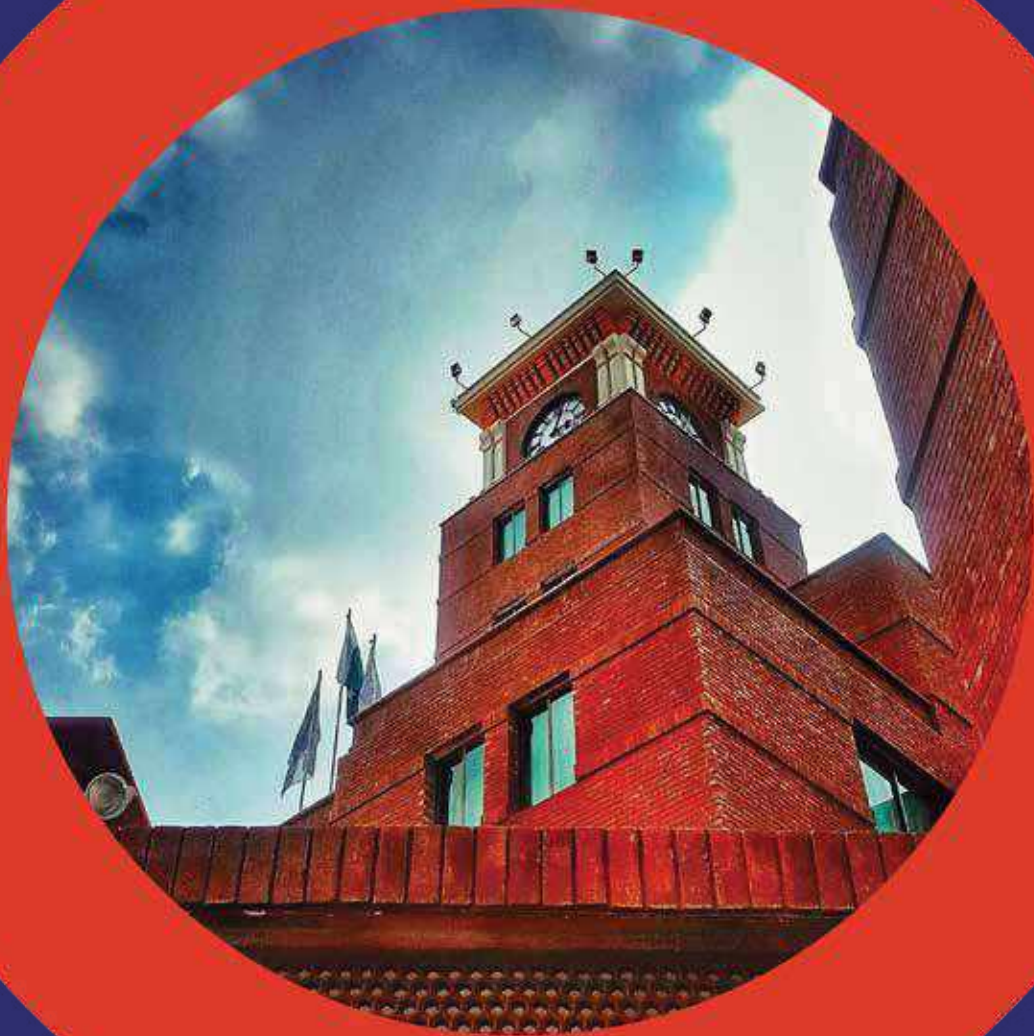

In-House Bookshop

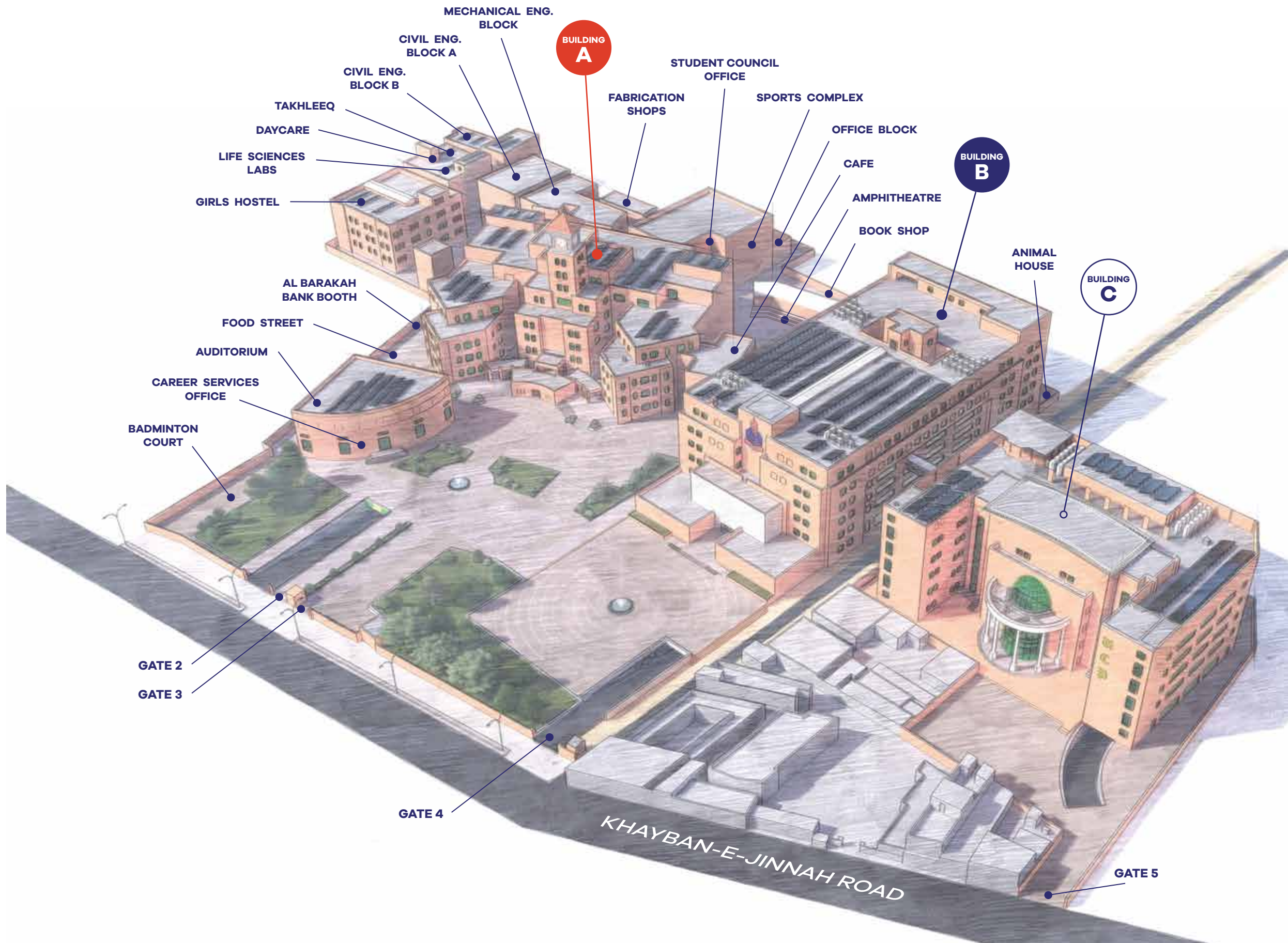

Under the VIS program, every student is required to register for volunteer work with one or more of the renowned partners of the VIS department before graduation. These partners include local and international organizations such as NGOs, NPOs, hospitals, rehabilitation centres, formal and informal schools, etc. Some of our partner organizations include UNAI, IAVE, WWF, GNVL, Shaukat Khanum Cancer Hospital, Akhuwat, Rescue 1122, Care Foundation, Fatimid, National Hospital, Shalimar Hospital, and many others.

To this date, over 20,000 volunteers have completed their VIS requirements with an average of 1,700 volunteers annually. It also has a pool of 165 partners including 33 hospitals, 13 schools, 6 Rehabilitation Centers & 113 NGO's. In September 2011 and 2019, our volunteers sprayed Dengue preventive chemicals in more than 1,000 houses and provided free diagnostic tests to hundreds of people who were unable to afford the test expenses. In support of Akhuwat Clothes Bank, UCP Volunteers have contributed more than 90,000 pairs of clothes. In 2015, a total of 1500 blankets and 5000 jerseys were donated to the victims of earthquake and flood in Chitral Partner of World Wildlife Fund (WWF) and VSO International.

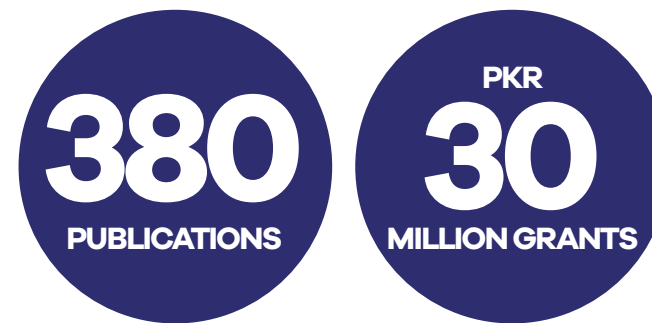

OUR SCHOLARSHIPS

At University of Central Punjab (UCP), we award generous scholarships to our students in the form of tuition fee waivers/concessions. At the start of a degree program, we award scholarships based on the applicant's earlier academic credentials, which may have a specific definition for a given degree program. To continue with awarded scholarship in subsequent semesters, there are continuation conditions such as the applicant's CGPA and the academic record of the last semester. The applicant must fulfil the prescribed conditions to continue the scholarship in the next semester. Failing to comply with these conditions shall lead to the cancellation of the awarded scholarship, at least for one semester. We reinstate the scholarship once the prescribed conditions are met.

The University for the time being awards scholarships under the following heads:

Kinship Scholarship

To lessen the educational expense burden upon parents/guardians, the UCP offers Kinship Discount when two or more siblings are currently enrolled at UCP.

PGC Scholarship

UCP staunchly believes in uplifting its graduates to pursue higher studies. Therefore, students with an Intermediate from Punjab College, and UCP Undergraduate students are eligible to apply for this scholarship in pursuit of their degree.

Alumni Scholarship

To lessen the educational expense burden upon parents/guardians, the UCP offers Kinship Discount when two or more siblings are currently enrolled at UCP.

Merit Scholarship

To award students with an outstanding academic record, UCP offers up to 100% Merit-Based Scholarship.

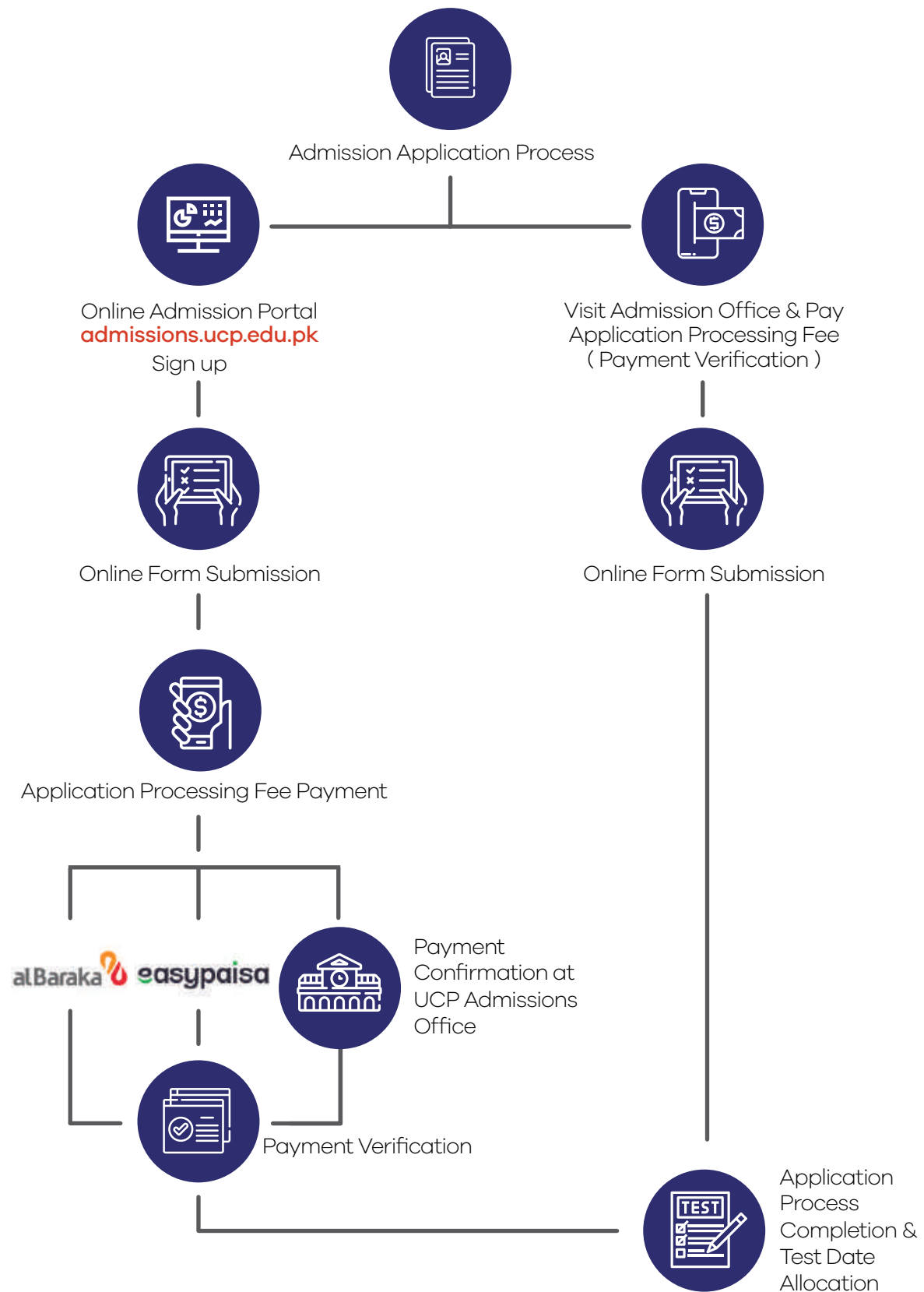
The University of Central Punjab invites applications for admissions to its various programs twice a year, once in Fall and then in Spring.

However, Faculty of Engineering, Faculty of Pharmacy and Faculty of Law announce admissions in Fall only.

Follow these steps to apply for admission at University of Central Punjab

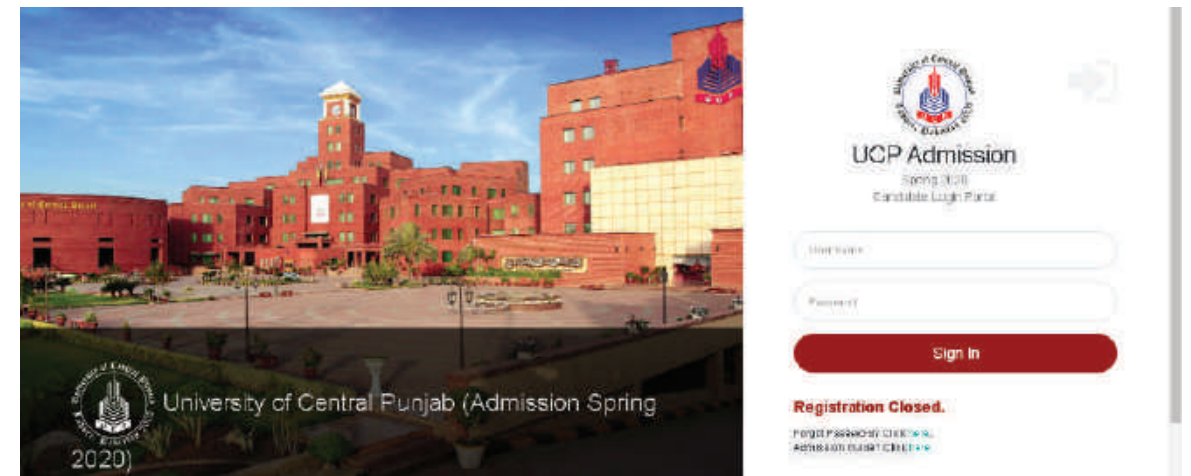
STEP 1	Students who are interested to apply are advised to visit the campus or our official website ucp.edu.pk for detailed information about admission to their respective programs, fee structure and scholarship policy.
STEP 2	After deciding the program, apply online by filling out the form at admissions.ucp.edu.pk and then pay application processing fee (Rs.1000/-) through easypaisa, Albaraka Bank or at the Admissions Office.
STEP 3	The complete admission form can be submitted online by using the UCP Online Admission Portal. After submission of the form, a candidate will get a letter bearing all admission related information such as, reference number, admission test date, date of interview (if any) along with the venue of the test.
STEP 4	The merit list of successful candidates is displayed on the official website of UCP and is also accessible at merit.ucp.edu.pk . Admission Offer letters appear in the Admission Portal of each candidate which has all the information related to the admissions such as, fee payment deadline, fee payment process, fee refund policy etc.
STEP 5	Fee Challans are accessible on online admission portal and can be collected by visiting the UCP Services Centre after showing the academic documents. Applicants can also write an email to info.ssc@ucp.edu.pk to get the fee challan online if it is not available on the admission portal.
STEP 6	The semester fee can be paid at any branch of The Bank of Punjab/Al Baraka Bank or at the bank booth available at UCP Student Services Centre or fee can also be paid online. All these methods are mentioned in detail on the fee challan as well. The detailed process is given below:

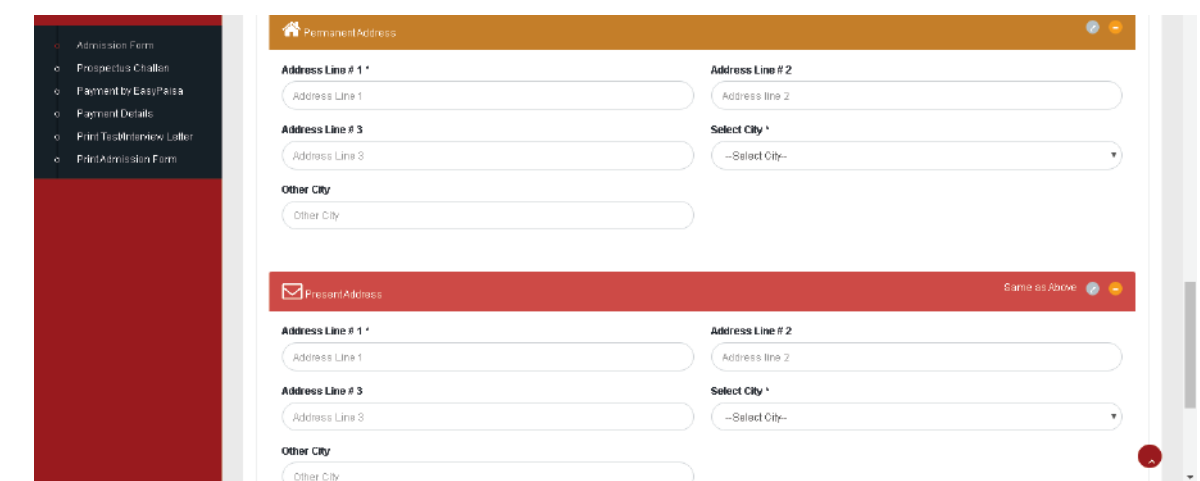
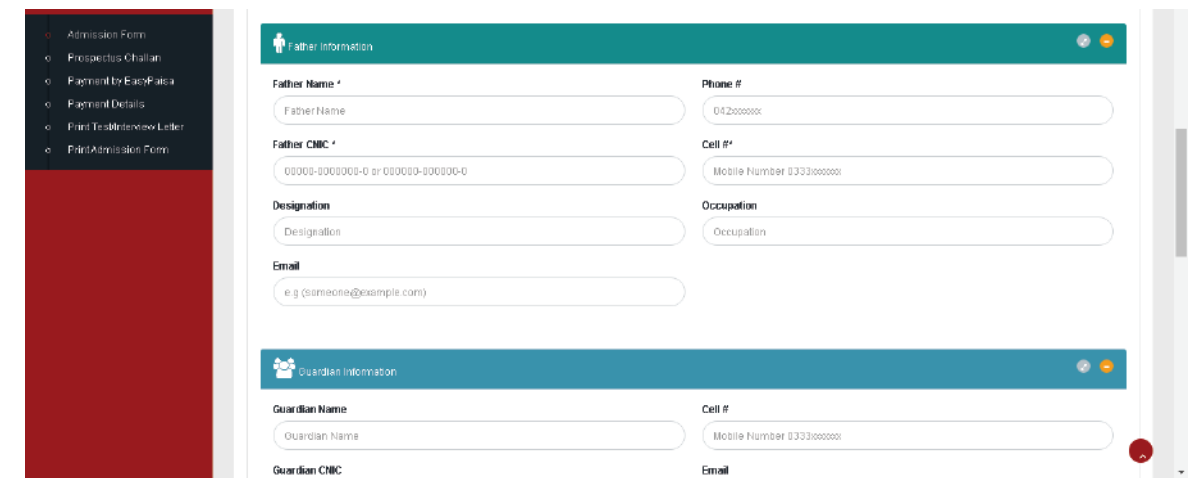
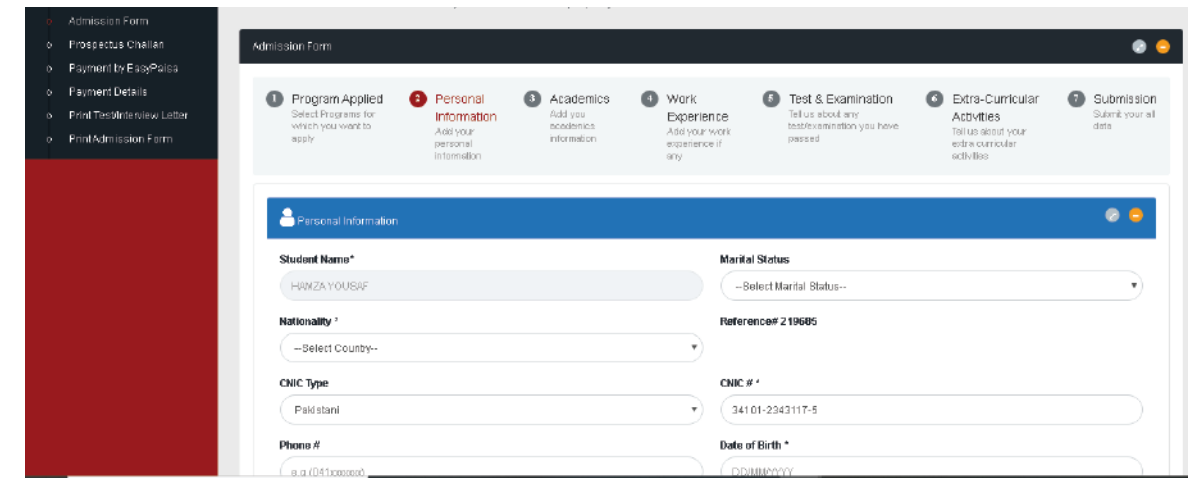
After clicking the Admission Form button, the candidate has to select the program that he/she wants to apply in along with two preferences.

Step 3: Academics

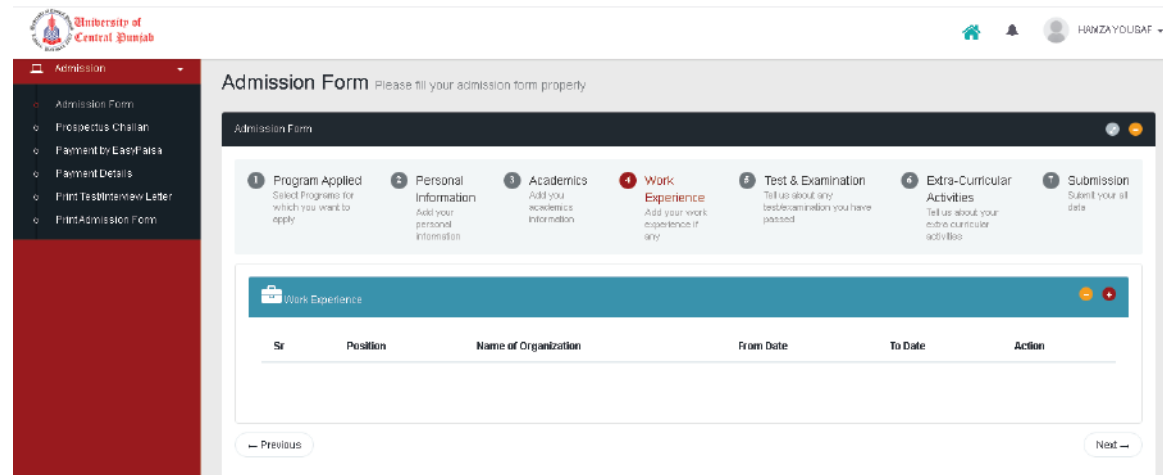
In this section, candidates need to enter their academic record from Matric to the most recent. To enter the record press the button with "+" sign.

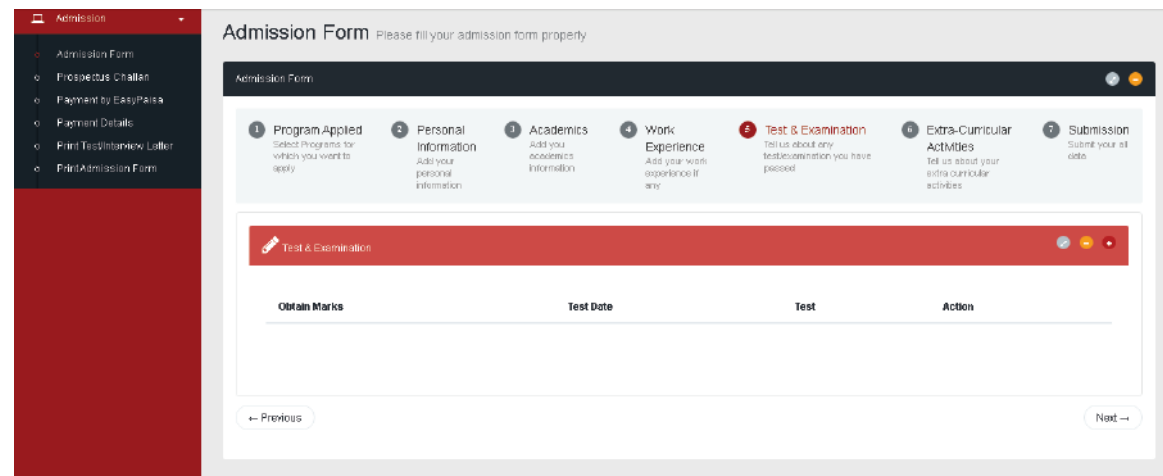
Step 4: Work Experience

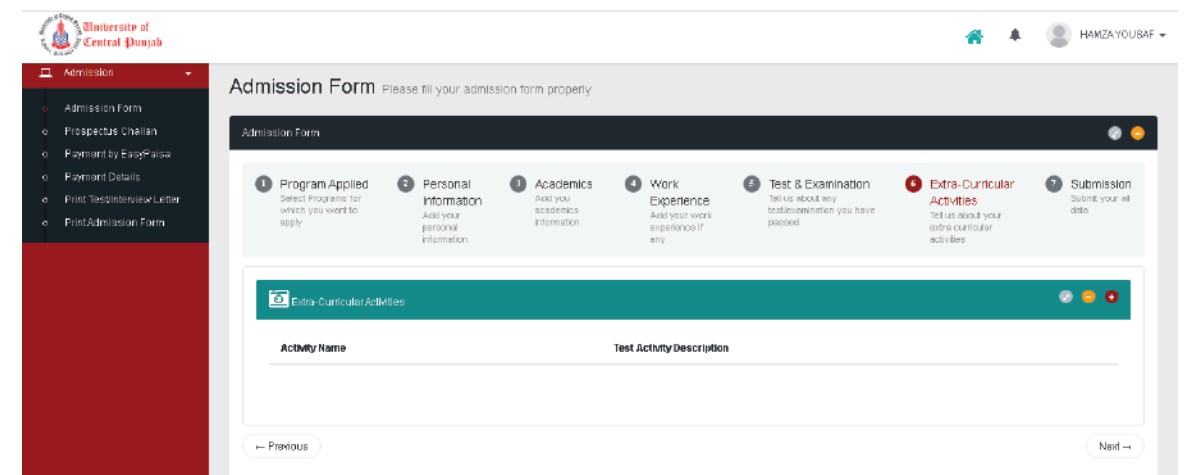
Step 5: Test and Examination

It is mandatory to give the UCP In-House Test, but if someone has given LAT/NTS/ECAT/SAT, they can enter their score under this portion.

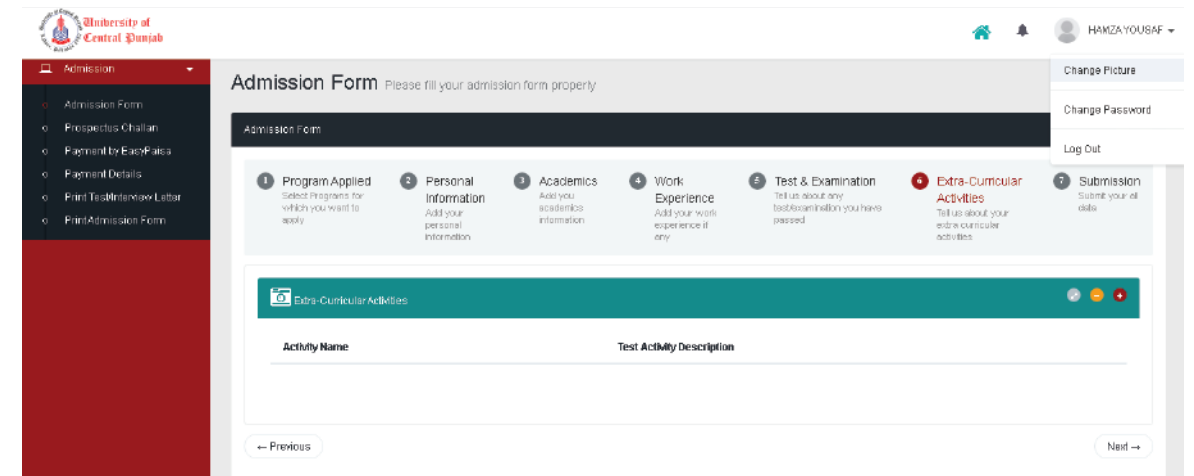


Step 6: Extra-Curricular Activities

Now is the final step of the online form. In the Submission section, the candidate must check and confirm all the details. At the bottom, the candidate can see scholarship options. They can select any option according to their eligibility.

After selecting the scholarship and before submitting the Admission Form, the candidates have to take an undertaking which outlines that all the information provided by them is correct. Once a candidate submits the Form, a Test/Interview letter is available that the candidates are required to take a print out of, as they have to bring it with them on the day of the test.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQs)

Scholarships and Financial Aid

1. What are the criteria to keep Merit / PGC / Kinship Scholarship?

Ans: Criteria for various types of scholarships varies across the board. For further details regarding the type of scholarship you are interested in please visit the website at:

2. What is the required course load to keep the scholarship?

Ans: For Undergraduate Programs scholarship you must earn the required CGPA with a minimum load of 12 credit hours. For Graduate Programs scholarship, you must earn the required CGPA with a minimum load of 9 credit hours.

3. What is the procedure to obtain financial aid in case of death of father/guardian during studies at UCP?

Ans: In such instances, the student can apply for financial assistance. We offer financial aid of up to 50% to the student on the recommendation of an assessment committee. Such students must maintain a minimum of 3.00 CGPA.

4. What is the process to apply for a need-based scholarship?

Ans: In such instances, the student can apply for financial assistance. We offer financial aid of up to 50% to the student on the recommendation of an assessment committee. Such students must maintain a minimum of 3.00 CGPA.

5. Is there any sports-based scholarship available?

Ans: Applicants can apply for a sports-based scholarship if they have played on National/International/District/Provincial level. However, they must qualify the trials to qualify for a scholarship.

Attendance, Semester Break and Course addition Withdrawl/Transfer

6. What is the university's policy regarding attendance and leaves?

7. What is the process to apply for Semester Freeze/Break?

Ans: Students who wish to discontinue study for a semester must receive written permission from the Dean's Office in the first week of the semester. The student must submit the signed application to SSC and pay the semester break charges of PKR 5,000.

8. What is the process to transfer to another program within/outside UCP?

9. What is the course withdrawal process and policy?

Ans: To withdraw from a course(s), students have to submit the "Course Withdrawal Form" at SSC after the due approval by the concerned Dean/Associate Dean within the dates published by the Registrar Office in the University Academic Calendar. Please note that a W grade will appear on the transcript and fees paid for such courses are neither refundable nor carried over to the next semester.

10. What is the process of course(s) add/drop?

Ans: A registered student in a semester can exercise the Add/Drop facility after the submission of initial registration fee challan form within the dates published by the Registrar Office in the University Academic Calendar for a particular semester.

11. What is the procedure to apply for inter-faculty program transfer?

Ans: Students may apply for the change of program from an existing program to any other offered program of UCP subject to the eligibility criteria of the new program. The student should submit the Program Transfer Form at SSC after due approval from both faculty Deans within the dates published by the Registrar Office in the University Academic Calendar.

12. What if I want to transfer my course/courses from an earlier University?

Ans: If an applicant would like to transfer his/her courses from their current university to UCP, they must ensure that HEC recognizes that university and program. The applicant must apply as a fresh candidate and appear for the test and interview to appear in the merit list. Program eligibility and criteria set by UCP will apply. If admitted, the applicant can only transfer

50% of the courses with a C+ and above grade (subject to the evaluation of course). The respective department analyses the course outlines to determine the similarity of these courses in our program structure. After this deliberation, the department decides if they want to allow the transfer of said courses.

13. How can I pay my fee challan form?

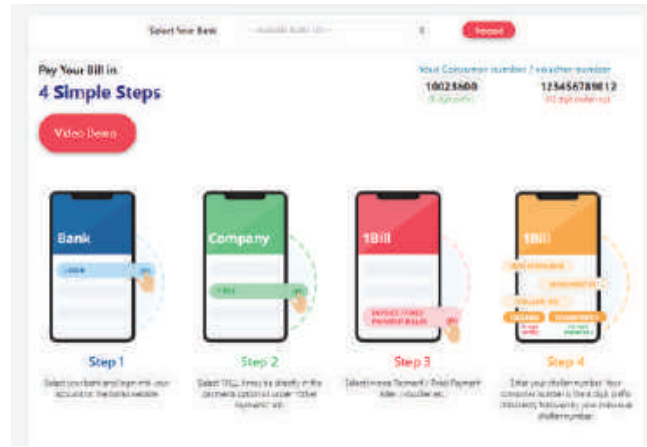

14. Can we make the payment online? If yes, what is the process for the online payment process?

Ans: The University of Central Punjab has always been steadfast in the mission to facilitate its students. In the same regard, UCP students can now pay their fee voucher through online payment portal via internet banking services. 15. What is the challan form issuance process?

Ans: Candidates selected in the merit list have the option to access the fee challan online. Candidates also have the option to visit UCP Student Services Centre to get their fee challan. They must bring their original academic documents and one set of their photocopy on this visit.

16. What is the fee refund policy?

Ans: The University Fee Refund Policy is as follows:

- Admission fee is NON-REFUNDABLE
- 100% tuition fee is refundable if the refund request gets received before the commencement of classes
- 100% tuition fee is refundable if the refund request gets received within the 1st week of classes
- 50% tuition fee is refundable if the refund request is received in the 2nd week of classes

- No fee is refundable after the 2nd week of classes

Note: You must fill and submit the prescribed form available at the Admissions Office to process your fee refund request

17. What is the process of semester fee payment?

Ans: You can pay the semester fee at any branch of The Bank of Punjab/AI Baraka Bank, the bank booth available at UCP Student Services Centre, or online. You can find these details on the fee challan as well. The detailed process is as follows:

- Deposit cash in any branch of AI Baraka Bank (Pakistan) Ltd/OneLink/The Bank of Punjab only
- Pay at the booth of AI Baraka Bank available at UCP Student Services Centre
- Pay Online by visiting pay.ucp.edu.pk for the following options:
 - Credit Card and Debit Card (Visa/Master)/EasyPaisa
