RESEARCH SHELF

Research initiatives and publications serve as an intellectual hub for an institute, providing an opportunity to its members to stay abreast of the latest developments in the field. The intellectual contribution of FMCS can be determined by the fact that our faculty members have published more than 52 research publications in various research journals. Some notable researches of our faculty members are:

"Meta analysis of smartphone usage for gratifications obtained (2016-2019)" collaboratively written by Ms. Robina Saeed and Dean FMCS, Prof. Dr. Taimoor-ul-Hassan.

Another research, titled as "Evaluating the effectiveness of news management software's: A study of Pakistan's news channels" is published in Journal of Social Science Research by Prof. Dr. Taimoor-ul-Hassan along with Mr. Ali Ashraf and Mr. Farahat Ali. The study discusses usage of software in the TV industry and its implication for information quality.

Analyzing the effects of media on child psychology, Ms. Muniba Fatima Zahra, Dr. Fawad Baig and Prof. Dr. Taimoor-ul-Hassan have jointly worked on a fruitful study, "Media exposure and child psychology: Parental perceptions about effects" which has been accepted for publication in Academic Journal of Interdisciplinary Studies.

FACULTY ACHIEVEMENTS

Ms. Atiya Dar, Senior Lecturer at FMCS has successfully completed her Doctorate degree (Ph.D.) in the field of Communication Studies from Department of Communication Studies Bahauddin Zakariya University, Multan.
